This year marks the 29th year of the Ekka presenting its most glamorous event, the Fashion Parades.

The Natural Fibres Fashion Parade, in the Channel 7 Pavilion,

is directed for the fourth year by Laura Churchill who has always worked in the Queensland fashion industry, and has progressed from a journalist to a producer.

All garments included in the show are made from natural fibres and tell a story from fibre to fashion reflecting the theme of the parade, 'Stories of Style'.

"The inspiration came from really wanting to ensure people knew how these designers are so clever in doing what they're doing and how that relates back to the Ekka." Laura said.

"Because the crowd is so diverse, we have to make sure we have something to please everyone," she said.

This year's Natural Fibres Fashion Parade showcases 16 labels and student designers from three design colleges in four categories – day wear, occasional wear, formal / bridal wear and student designs.
