The Council is making the Metro as environmentally friendly as possible by making it electric.

The Metro line is estimated to be completed in 2023.

Visit the Brisbane City Council Stall for drawings and foldable templates of models of the new Metro vehicles along with CityCats and buses.

In the Channel 7 Pavilion the Brisbane City Council has a display showcasing the new Metro system.

Improving public transport flow across the Victoria Bridge is one of the project's main goals.

Brisbane City Council officers are explaining the new system to Ekka visitors.

"The Metro will take away a lot of those little buses, there will be less congestion at the Cultural Centre and it will make a quicker trip through the city," an BCC officer said.

He describes the look of the new Metro as "a big long bus".

Once complete, the Metro will travel to new locations, including the Royal Brisbane Hospital and the University of Queensland.
