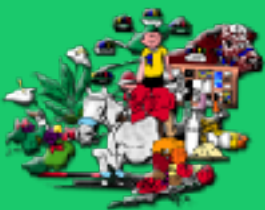

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the Ekka has been cancelled, but some traditions will continue.

Competitions and information sessions will be presented online, and the delicious Strawberry Sundaes will also be available to enjoy in your very own home.

Around Brisbane, there will be pop-ups where you can purchase your favourite Ekka treats of Dagwood Dogs, Tasting plates and, of course, Strawberry Sundaes.

These pop-ups will be at a number of locations around Brisbane including King George Square and Skygate (near the Airport). The Brisbane Showgrounds Drive Through will be located in Sideshow Alley with entry via O'Connell Terrace and there is a store in King Street which sells the Tasting plates.

DIY Strawberry Sundae packs can also be pre-ordered. The packs include tubs of Ekka strawberry ice-cream, vanilla ice-cream, whipped cream, Queensland strawberries, ice-cream cones, scoops, strawberry spoons, hair nets, gloves and aprons. They come in two sizes; packs to make 20 sundaes, or packs to make 100 sundaes, which is good for workplaces, schools or community groups.

All proceeds of the sale of the sundaes goes to The Prince Charles Hospital Foundation which is involved in medical research including research into Coronavirus.
