The Heritage Bank Racing Pigs Show is being presented each day at the Stockman's Rest by the Vandeleur family.

Two races each feature four pigs running around a 50 metre track,

while being cheered by their section of the crowd.

After the warm-up races, the pigs run up a two metre high ramp and leap into a tank of water below.

The Vandeleurs have raced their pigs at the Ekka every year since 1993 and the Show continues to be a crowd favourite.

Mater Vandeleur, who is 11 years old, helps his family to raise the pigs and commentates at the event.

"It takes three weeks to train them and we have 11 pigs in total," he said.
