Our initiatives include

- Application of centre resources including staff time, expertise, and funds to meet the needs of our diverse learners in programs of high demand.
 - **Evidence:** specialised resource development (e.g., Vyond animated videos) to improve literacy of students in the contextual language embedded in Centre programs prior to attending the program. Interview data collected from students will also be used to feedback further development in this area.
- USO's to be utilised to increase collection of feedback data to inform development/enhancement of centre programs.

Evidence: 70% of Visiting Teacher Feedback surveys completed to increase sample size of collected data and increased use of student interviews to capture "rich data" to further inform pedagogical improvements.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Developing animated Vyond videos that provide an engaging medium to enable improved literacy development prior to students participating in Centre programs. Students who participate in Centre programs with a greater understanding of the context are more engaged and can connect with the curriculum at a deeper level.
- Increased collection of feedback and data will enable Centre staff to better direct improvement strategies. Utilising USO's to collect and represent this data enables teaching staff to focus on connecting students with the curriculum.
